RWANDA



Rwanda is a beautiful mountainous nation in Eastern Africa. About 11 years ago massive genocide took place in the country with 1 million people being killed in 100 days. The stories that survivors tell are heart-wrenching, but yet stories of survival in a time when no one should have lived.

In spite of the past, the church in that land is exploding with growth. Several churches are now running over 1,000 people, and the latest report is that there are 140 Assemblies of God congregations.

Africa Tabernacle Evangelism has played a vital role in the establishment of the church. Most of the early churches are tabernacles that have become too small. I recently visited the church pastored by General Superintendent Gatabazi. They are currently in their third building program. I saw the original tabernacle, then where they actually meet now, and finally the beginnings of their new building that is designed to seat 5,000 people.

Many times, we realize that a tabernacle is only the first of many building phases the church goes through because we believe that they will soon outgrow it. Yet, it does become their place of worship and they can start their growth process from there.

The Bible School in the capital city of Kigali is almost exclusively tabernacle construction. It is a beautiful campus that sits on the side of a hill just below the international airport. Not only are there the normal Bible School buildings, but there are two houses for our missionaries, made from tabernacles, that are on the campus.

The needs for Rwanda are great. Please pray that customs issues regarding the importation of tabernacles may be resolved soon so we can send more buildings in. Pray that the lingering bitterness between the tribes would go away and in unity they may touch the entire nation for Christ. And finally pray that funds would come in to help get more of these 140 congregations in a church of their own.
