### A WORD FROM THE DIRECTOR

I recently had the privilege of working in Zimbabwe with Missionary Dean Galyen and ATE friend Jeff Wishop to erect three tabernacles. One of these was in the Harare area, and two of them were in the southern part of the country near the town of Gwanda.

Though Zimbabwe is in an economic crisis and many goods are not available, Dean was able to secure materials for the tabernacles in country. Unfortunately, the cost is about triple the cost of those coming from the USA. This almost makes it cost prohibitive, yet the work must go on.

We have just sent Dean an "invoice" for shipping tabernacles in from the USA so he can present it to customs in order to get a ruling from them regarding import duty. In the past, their rulings prevented us from bringing them in, so please pray that this time they will give us a break and we can once again ship in tabernacles with either low or no duty.
