KISANGANI FOR CHRIST UPDATE

About 18 months ago, we partnered with the Congo church in the city of Kisangani for a city-wide crusade. This outreach was held over a 13-week period and around 11,000 people were either saved for the first time or they rededicated their lives to Christ.

Due to the logistical inability to bring in full church structures, we partnered in different ways, and one way was to provide money for roofing only. We have just received word that at one of these locations where \$2000 was provided for a roof, the project has been completed AND the church has grown by 288 people. In addition, that church has started another church and it now has an attendance of 225 - to God be the glory!

TABERNACLE COUNT

Our latest figures show that ATE and our partners have erected 2,047 churches, and that is enough to hold well over half a million believers.

What I find awesome, is that often when I go back to visit a tabernacle we put up earlier, the building has been expanded to hold more people. I just visited a church that has expanded the size of the building and is about to do it again. They are running in excess of 1200 people each Sunday. That is what your going, giving, and praying is all about!

MALAWI FABRICATION PLANT

By the time you receive this newsletter, our fabrication plant in Malawi will be up and running. Due to various issues with the customs officials, it took quite awhile to get the containers of goods in. However, it has arrived, and includes welders, grinders, punches, shears, generators and lots of other pieces of equipment.

Once the container arrived, our colleague, Bobby Smith, flew to Malawi to organize the factory. We have a team of welders from Wichita Falls, TX ready to go and put the factory to use in the not-too-distant future. This will allow us to fabricate more churches at lower costs, therefore, more people can hear the gospel of Christ.
