Though the last couple of years have been financially tough in the USA - God has, through you, remained faithful. December 2009 was one of the best financial months we have had. And with all of the processes we have to go through to get tabernacles built and sent, we are seeing a lot happen right now.

We sent a shipment of 7 tabernacles to Madagascar and they have now been received. Just yesterday, we sent out 4 tabernacles and two large evangelism tents to Malawi. We are in the final stages of preparing 7 tabernacles to go to Congo and those will probably be sent before you read this letter. Ten tabernacles are currently being manufactured and will be sent to Tanzania within the next month. And I am about to leave for Zimbabwe to put up a very large tabernacle in Harare with missionaries Dean Galyen, Charles Hasselbring, and layman Bobby Smith. And finally, through the generosity of a wonderful partner, Charles Keisser, we have another going up in Cameroon. That brings the total to 30 churches we are now in the process of building.

Thank you, our faithful donors who help make this happen. Without you, it would be impossible to continue this work. May God bless you as together, we build His kingdom.

One of the longest roads a missionary travels is that of itineration (traveling church to church raising monthly support base for the work ahead). Some of the missionaries love that road, but it can be quite stressful.

Our newest missionaries, Charlie and Vicki Brown, have now completed their travels successfully. They have received their final clearance and will soon begin the next season of

their ministry. Vicki will continue to handle much of the administrative work of ATE while Charlie will be building, leading teams, and kicking off some new initiatives. Congratulations Charlie and Vicki, and welcome aboard in this new full-time and appointed missionary status!



A NEW LOOK



We are always looking for new ways to do things and to save money. One of our team members, Bobby Smith, has come up with a way to build a very strong building, yet save costs. We have erected what he fabricated and had a structural engineer evaluate it and give his endorsement to it, and now he is fabricating the first load to go to Tanzania. One good thing is that due to the style, we will be able to get at least 10 buildings in a container, thus saving costs per tab on shipping. Right now, we believe we will be able to do everything for less than \$5,000 per tab, but once we get in the final numbers, we will know for sure.

Much of this savings is due to donated labor. Bobby is using his shop to do the work, donating his time and labor along with others who have been coming to help cut, drill, weld, paint, etc. Thank you Bobby for all you do!
